For neuropsychologists, especially those wishing to work in the medico-legal context, your credibility is directly connected to your reports. Your written communication and ability to integrate assessment information, neuropsychological knowledge, research literature, opinions and recommendations play an important part in displaying your professionalism.

This workshop aims to better equip psychologists with the necessary skills for professional report writing. As SACNA has recognised a need in this area, special focus will be given to neuropsychological report writing. Practical examples of reports will also be shared and workshopped.
